Dear Farmingdale families,

If you are receiving this letter, it means that I have medication for your child that I need to return to you. New Jersey Administrative Code prohibits schools to keep medications in the Health Office past the end of the current school year. This year, due to COVID-19 and contactless distribution protocols, **all medications will be secured and returned to you in your student's brown bag when you arrive for your exchange of materials day** as provided in Mrs. Conroy's previous letter. Any medications not picked up will be discarded.

If you anticipate your student needing medication for next school year, please have your physician complete the following forms. All forms can be found on the school website under the tab "Virtual Backpack".

Some reminders:

- Any over-the-counter or prescription medications require the Medication Permission form to be completed.
- A FARE form, in addition to the Medication Permission form, needs to be completed for any emergency epinephrine to be kept in school.
- An Asthma Action Plan, in addition to the Medication Permission form needs to be completed for any inhalers or nebulizers to be used in school.
- Remember to add a parent signature where indicated on all forms.
