Last week, information was sent home regarding the Magnet and International Baccalaureate programs offered through the Freehold Regional High School District (FRHSD). In addition to these programs, Farmingdale students are eligible to apply to **one** of the six "Career Academies" of the Monmouth County Vocational School District (MCVSD). Like the FRHSD programs, these specialized, tuition-free, programs have an application process and offer information sessions. - Academy of Allied Health and Science (located in Neptune)
- Biotechnology High School (located in Freehold)
- Communications High School (located in Wall)
- High Technology High School (located in Lincroft)
- Marine Academy of Science and Technology (located in Highland)
- Academy of Law & Public Safety (located in Long Branch)

MCVSD is limiting the number of attendees to the information sessions, so only 8th grade students along with up to 2 parent/guardians may attend. Students may only attend one information session per school, though they may attend an information session at each of the six career academies to help them decide where they might like to apply. However, **students must have attended the entire presentation for the school to which they apply.**

The information sessions begin in late September and run through mid-November.

Registration is not required to attend any information session.
