program in which students are tutored in a small group  
setting by graduate students. The clinic is held once a  
week on Thursdays at the Monmouth University Graduate  
Center. The clinic dates are as follows: September 23<sup>rd</sup>,  
September 30<sup>th</sup>, October 7<sup>th</sup>, October 14<sup>th</sup>, October 21<sup>st</sup>,  
October 28<sup>th</sup>, November 4<sup>th</sup>, and November 11<sup>th</sup>. Clinic  
sessions will begin at 4:30pm and end at 6:00pm.

Attendance and being prompt for  
each session is key to the success  
of the program. Parents are  
responsible for transportation.



The cost is \$100 per child for the  
entirety of the clinic. Applicants will be chosen by lottery.
